




BEFORE PERFORMING AUTO LEVELING PROCEDURES, ELEVATE ONLY THE LEFT REAR CORNER OF THE COACH BY DRIVING ONTO A 3" RAMP OR BLOCK. REPEAT THE AUTO LEVELING PROCEDURES WITH ONLY THE RIGHT REAR CORNER ELEVATED 3".

9. AUTO LEVELING - 1ST STAGE: POSITION THE VEHICLE SO ONE OR MORE YELLOW LEVELING LIGHTS ARE ON. PUSH THE "I" BUTTON ONCE TO TURN THE SYSTEM ON. [COMMENTS]		
<b>10. AUTO LEVELING - 2ND STAGE:</b> PUSH THE "I" BUTTON AGAIN (2ND) TIME.		
A. THE "HYDRAULIC OPERATION" INDICATOR LIGHT WILL START TO BLINK.		
B. AIR WILL DUMP FOR 25 SECONDS BEFORE STARTING TO LEVEL.		
C. TWO JACKS AT A TIME WILL EXTEND CORRESPONDING TO ANY YELLOW LIGHT WHICH THE PUMP WILL CYCLE ON AND OFF AS REQUIRED. THERE IS A SHORT DELAY BETWEEN OPERATION OF THE JACKS. THIS SHOULD CONTINUE UNTIL ALL YELLOW LIGHTS ARE OU UNTIL ONE JACK HAS REACHED FULL STROKE.		
<b>NOTE:</b> IF THE "EXCESS SLOPE" LIGHT COMES ON, THE HYDRAULIC OPERATION LIGHT WIL OFF. THE "EXCESS SLOPE" LIGHT WILL STAY ON. PUSH THE "STORE" BUTTON AND ALLO JACKS TO RETRACT COMPLETELY.		
D. THE PUMP WILL COME BACK ON. DURING THIS TIME ANY JACKS NOT ALREADY TOUCH THE GROUND WILL BE EXTENDED TO STABILIZE THE VEHICLE.	HING

E. THE "HYDRAULIC OPERATION" LIGHT WILL GO OUT. [COMMENTS]		
<b>11. SENSING UNIT:</b> AFTER AUTO LEVELING-2ND STAGE, ALL YELLOW LEVELING LIGHTS SHOULD BE OUT. CHECK WITH A LEVEL TO SEE THAT THE VEHICLE IS LEVEL. IF IT IS, THE SENSING UNIT IS PROPERLY ADJUSTED. <b>[COMMENTS]</b>		
<b>12. AUTOMATIC RETRACT (STORE):</b> THE IGNITION SWITCH MUST BE IN THE "ON" POSITION WITH THE ENGINE RUNNING. PUSH THE "STORE" BUTTON ONE TIME.		
A. THE "JACK STORAGE" INDICATOR LIGHT WILL START TO FLASH.		
B. THE RED WARNING LIGHTS SHOULD BE OUT WHEN THE JACKS ARE FULLY RETRACTED	D.	
C. THE GREEN "TRAVEL" INDICATOR LIGHT SHOULD COME ON WHEN THE RED WARNING LIGHTS ARE OUT.		
D. THE SYSTEM WILL AUTOMATICALLY SHUT DOWN SIX MINUTES AFTER ALL THE JACKS ARE RETRACTED. ALL LIGHTS ON THE TOUCH PANEL SHOULD NOW BE OUT EXCEPT THE "TRAVEL" LIGHT.
